## AASA Testing

Our 3rd–8th grade learners will be participating in the 2026 AASA State Assessments this month. Each learner will complete assessments in Writing, English Language Arts (ELA), and Math, as required by the state of Arizona. The ELA assessment is divided into three sections, while the Math assessment includes two sections. Learners are typically scheduled to complete one section per day, with additional sessions available for any missed testing due to absences.

These assessments are designed to measure learner progress in relation to the Arizona State Standards and provide valuable insight into academic growth.

At Incito, we recognize that learning and intelligence are demonstrated in many ways, and these assessments represent just one snapshot of our learners' abilities. We encourage each learner to approach testing with confidence, take their time, and put forth their best effort.

Families can play an important role in supporting a successful testing experience by encouraging a positive mindset and perseverance. Ensuring learners get a restful night of sleep and a healthy breakfast each morning can make a meaningful difference.

If your learner has a scheduled appointment or will need to leave campus early, please communicate with their Educator in advance. Leaving during a testing session will result in the assessment being closed and not eligible for completion.

Your learner's Educator can provide specific testing schedules as needed. We are incredibly proud of our learners and look forward to seeing them shine during this testing season!
